



SPC INKS MOU WITH MAE FAH LUANG UNIVERSITY (Thailand)

The Department of Nursing of San Pedro College and the School of Nursing of Mae Fah Luang University of Thailand have forged an Agreement on Academic Cooperation and Exchange. Through the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), SPC and Mae Fah Luang University agreed to encourage and promote the following activities in their respective institutions: exchange of faculty and staff; exchange of students; exchange of publications and relevant academic and scholarly information; joint research, lectures and symposia; and other activities as deemed appropriate by mutual consent.

The agreement was signed during a formal ceremony held last January 26, 2017 at the Labrecque Hall of San Pedro College. Signatories to the said MOU were Dr. Romyen Kosaikanont, MFU Vice President; Dr. Desiderio N. Noveno, Jr, SPC Interim President; Dr. Chomnard Potjanamard, Vice Dean, MFU School of Nursing; and Prof. Jeannie H. Bibera, SPC Dean of Nursing. The MOU signing was also attended by Dr. Raul C. Alvarez, Jr, CHED –XI Director, who also gave an Inspirational Message; Sr. Aida T. Frencillo, OP, Chair, SPC Board of Trustees; Dr. Pimrat Boonyapuk, Nurse Lecturer, MFU; Ms. Thanya Thamjai, MFU International Affairs Division Officer; SPC Administrators; SPC Nursing faculty and students. This is the second MOU of SPC Nursing Department with a foreign higher education institution. SPC also has an agreement for Clinical Attachment with Ngee Ann Polytechnic – Singapore.
